



HOKAMIX

Directions for Use

HOKAMIX25 can be used for dogs and cats.

Please follow the specific instructions for your pet.

Hokamix, combined with a high-quality food, will benefit pets of all ages. When first introducing Hokamix to your pet it is necessary to work up to the recommended daily intake by gradually increasing the amount added to the food over a 1-2-week period. Adjust Hokamix according to your pets' weight, size, breed and bowl tolerance. If your pets stool loses its form, reduce the amount of Hokamix given. Continue to reduce until stools are of normal form

Pets will generally accept Hokamix better when it is mixed into a moist food. Your pet's digestive system is designed to process food which has a moisture content of 80 to 90%. Digestive enzymes do not break down or convert food into its proper form while it is in the dry state.

When dry food/kibble is used Hokamix has a tendency to fall to the bottom of the bowl and your pet may not receive the full dosage, therefore dry food by itself is not recommended. Dry food should be moistened before mixing in Hokamix. If you feed dry kibble pet food, it is advised to soak the food in warm water for 10 minutes. This allows the water to absorb into the food. Yogurt or other foods can be added for palatability.

If your dog is a picky eater try Hokamix in tablet form.

Add the appropriate amount of Hokamix to your pet's food following instructions below

Hokamix25 Powder:

5-gram scoop enclosed

Instructions for Dogs:

The Recommended Daily Intake

(R.D.I.) of Hokamix is one 5-gram scoop per 10 Lbs. of body weight, to a maximum of 3 scoops a day, even if your dog weighs more than 30 lbs. If your pet is fed twice a day, you can divide the R.D.I into two equal portions.

For dogs with severe problems, hip dysplasia, arthritis, allergies, etc. you should double the R.D.I or administer as close to a double dose as the bowel will allow for at least six weeks and then return to normal R.D.I.

Instructions for Cats:

When first introducing Hokamix to your cat it is necessary to work up to the recommended daily intake by gradually increasing the amount added to the food over a 1-2-week period, or adjust to bowel tolerance.

The Recommended Daily Intake (R.D.I.) of Hokamix is 1/2 to 3/4 of a scoop per day depending on your cat's weight. 1/2 scoop is the normal R.D.I. If your pet is fed twice a day, you can divide the R.D.I into two equal portions.

IMPORTANT:

DO NOT DOUBLE THE DOSE FOR CATS



Hokamix25 Tablets:

Hokamix Tablets offer a healthy alternative for those dogs who object to additives in their food. Hokamix in tablet form can be given as a treat, which makes it a good choice for dogs that are picky eaters. Hokamix in tablet form is not recommended for cats, they seem to prefer the powder.

The tablets can be given as a treat or added to your dog's food. Dry food should be moistened before mixing in the HOKAMIX tablets

Give the appropriate amount of Hokamix tablets to your dog following instructions below.

The Recommended Daily Intake (R.D.I.) of Hokamix is as follows:

Instructions for Puppies:

½ – 1 tablet a day.

Instructions for Adult dogs:


Bodyweight of 10 lbs., 2 tablets a day.

Bodyweight of 20 lbs., 4 tablets per day

Body weight of 30 lbs., 6 tablets per day

Large Breeds: Body weight of 50 lbs. or more

up to 8 tablets per day



Don't expect instant results. Improvements usually become apparent after 3 to 4 weeks of constant use. A disturbed balance in the body doesn't originate from one day to the other, this is something that happens over time. Restoring the balance, also takes time. With a little patience, dog owners have achieved astonishing results with Hokamix. Each pet's condition is different and may take a different length of time to improve.

We highly recommend purchasing the size designed for your size dog as you may run out of Hokamix just before the desired results are achieved.

After an initial period of continued use (6 to 8 months) a short break from Hokamix for 3 to 5 days every 4 months allows the herbs to work more effectively when the normal dosage is resumed.

We do not claim that Hokamix will cure all ills, but please give it a try you may be surprised!

Hokamix is not intended to replace normal veterinary medications.
